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INTRODUCTION

The collection

This collection relates to the Rathmolyon estate in county Meath. The earlier papers come from the Rawdon family, who held the estate in the eighteenth century. The estates passed into the hands of Rev. Robert Fowler, archbishop of Dublin, during the 1790s. In 1798 when Rev. Robert Fowler had a full survey of the property made the estate consisted of 4,416 acres.

The papers

A report on the Fowler papers was made by Sir John Ainsworth in 1958, *Report on Private Collections No. 449*. The majority of the papers assessed were donated to the National Library of Ireland in the same year by the Fowler family (Accession 1960). The documents within the collection are entirely estate papers, and are mainly leases, rental and accounts. The personal documents, letters and diaries listed in 1958 were not given to the library. The material in the collection covers the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries, the earliest document dating from 1710 and the latest from 1897. The collection is contained within 4 boxes and one volume of maps. The papers are generally in good condition. In addition some of the Fowler papers listed in *Report on Private Collections No. 449* have been previously assigned a manuscript number (**MS 11,411**) these are listed, with other additional papers in **Appendix 1**.

Arrangement

When this collection was acquired the original arrangement had been lost. The papers within this collection have been divided by type and then arranged chronologically. The six document types are; title deeds, leases and surrenders, agreements, rentals, accounts and estate maps.

Assessment

The papers are a small collection of estate papers, covering the Rathmolyon estate during the eighteenth and nineteenth century, particularly the leasing of lands. The collection lacks any title deeds relating to the estate, as well as the estate correspondence. However, the collection provides detail of the land holding and leasing pattern in this part of county Meath.




Rawdon, Earls of Moira pedigree
