History and Organization of the Collection

After the death of Sir Hugh (Percy) Lane on the *Lusitania* in 1915 his papers passed on to his sister Mrs. Ruth Shine (Later Mrs. A. R. Heaven). Material mostly relating to his death and his controversial will were added by Shine. On her death in 1959 the papers came into the custody of her executors, Mrs. G. de B. West (a cousin) and Mrs. Thistlethwaite, daughter of Harold Lane, brother of Sir Hugh Lane and Ruth Shine.

The material was acquired by the National Library between 1960 and 2000 and the various accessions have been catalogued at various times:
